Shelter is an exciting and different project. When winemakers put their blends together, they are often faced with tough decisions. For example, say there are 10 barrels each, of Cabernet from 4 different vineyard blocks. They are all great, and they have different personalities. However, when blended, one of the blocks' characteristics overwhelms the others too much, so it would be better to put only 8 of those barrels into the blend. What do you do with those extra 2 barrels of awesome Cabernet? This is where SHELTER comes in. Shelter is comprised of only the finest wines from some of the most famous vineyards, made by some of the most famous winemakers in Napa. Because of the sensitivity of the reputation and exclusivity of these vineyards, the source and winemaker will not be revealed. The wines, however, speak for themselves!

Amber Knolls....Fred Schrader gained fame in the wine world in 1992 when he and Ann Colgin produced the Colgin Schrader Cabernet from Herb Lamb Vineyard on Howell Mountain. With Thomas Brown at the helm, Schrader produces expressive, dramatic wines.

What started as a small, wine-by-the-glass project for Michael Greenlee (formerly at the Gotham Bar and Grill) has evolved into a solid Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon. Sourced from two vineyards in Rutherford and one in St. Helena. Made by talented winemaker Abe Schoener (the man behind the highly acclaimed Scholium Project wines). Only 400 cases produced.

Lail Vineyards 2004 J. Daniel Cuvee Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa 195.00
 Varietal/Vineyard: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon / Howell Mountain and Oakville, Napa Valley. Winemaker: Philippe Melka (Hundred Acre, Bryant, Vineyard 29, Caldwell, etc)...The Lail family has been producing wines in Napa Valley for five generations. Gustav Niebaum founded Inglenook in 1879 (now Niebaum-Coppola). His great-nephew was John Daniel who was responsible for the famous Inglenook 'Cask Selections', and later purchased the Napanook Vineyard. John's daughter Robin Lail created the Dominus brand from that famous Napanook vineyard, along with her sister Marcia Smith and Christian Moueix. Lail wines are extremely special. J. Daniel cuvee is the 'flagship' wine of the Lail portfolio. 900 cases...94 points, Robert Parker

Good deep ruby-red. Claret-like aromas of blackberry, currant bud, bitter chocolate, licorice and graphite, plus a whiff of garrigue. Juicy and laid-back, with firm, nicely integrated acids contributing to an impression of youthful austerity. Strong dark berry and graphite character in the mouth. Gains breadth on the back end, with the tannins substantial but nicely integrated. This very lively wine should be held for a couple of years... I love what he's done with his 2008 The Prisoner, a blend of 46% Zinfandel, 26% Cabernet Sauvignon, and the balance Syrah, Petite Sirah, Charbono, and Grenache. With over 15% alcohol, this is a big, sexy, fruit bomb boasting abundant amounts of black, blue, and red fruits along with pepper, spice box, earth, and herbs. It tastes like the unmanipulated essence of the fruit of a Mediterranean vineyard. Soft tannins, medium to full body, and a heady mouthfeel make this a seductive wine to enjoy over the next 2-3 years. Score: 90. —Robert Parker, December 2009.

2006 Geyserville Sonoma County (70% zinfandel, 18% carignane, 10% petite sirah and 2% mataro): Ruby-red. Black raspberry. blueberry, smoked meat and dried violet on the fresh nose. Juicy, sharply focused red and dark berry flavors are dusted with suave minerals and firmed by supple tannins, with an exotic floral pastille note emerging on the back. Finishes sappy, sweet and long, with a deeper cherry note. Already quite complex...
